A parent can apply for an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card for their child by following these steps: - Visit the official OCI services website and fill out the application form. - For minors, submit a separate application signed by both parents or legal guardians. - Upload scanned copies of required documents through the portal and pay the applicable fee. - If there are any changes to the child's passport, an OCI minor passport update must be completed on the official website to keep the OCI card valid.
